Attention all staff, residents, families and/or their representatives. Please be advised that we have recently had a few staff members test positive for COVID-19. NO residents have tested positive as of this time. As a result of these positive staff cases, visitation on certain halls will need to be curtailed in certain circumstances. What this means is that on the affected halls, visitation will need to be restricted to one visitation per resident per day. Up to 2 people can visit during this one visit per day.
